


BARDD Agile Portfolio

Introduction to Agile Course (I2A)

I2A is a rapid tour of Agile delivery methodologies that are currently used. The history of Agile, the philosophy, the principles and the terminology is reviewed. It looks at how Agile has been adopted and adapted at scale and how it has expanded beyond software development.

This course is a valuable precursor to other Agile training courses. It is of value for those who need to understand how Agile elements of their business are working but are not necessarily going to be practicing it themselves.

Government Compliant Agile[®] Course (GCA)

To meet the Digital Service Standard for public service delivery, government departments are required to comply with 18 criteria set out in the Service Manual. This includes use of Agile methods. BARDD's GCA course aims to demystify the Agile techniques described in the Service Manual and places them in the context of contemporary Agile methods.

The course is designed for suppliers who will need to work with government or organisations that build digital services for the public sector. The knowledge gained on this course will help suppliers demonstrate compliance with the Digital Service Standard.

Professional Scrum Master™ I Course (PSM I)*

PSM I covers the principles and processes of the Scrum framework, the role of the 'Scrum Master' and how to use Scrum to optimize value, productivity and the total cost of ownership of software products.

This course is the baseline knowledge necessary for any business professional to begin to operate in a Scrum environment. We recommend completing Professional Scrum Master II if you are going to be a Scrum Master.

Professional Scrum Master™ II Course (PSM2)*

PSM II supports the development of advanced scrum knowledge by providing case studies and scenarios that explore complex problems from the real world. It is delivered in the context of support to achieving PSM II Certification as an indication of Scrum Master expertise.

PSM II is aimed at practicing Scrum Masters, or those that will be required to undertake a role in complex or challenging delivery environments. It builds on the learning from the PSM I Course.

Professional Scrum Product Owner™ Course (PSPO)*

PSPO demonstrates how the Scrum framework improves product development efforts. Product Owners need to have a concrete understanding of everything that drives value from their products. The breadth of the role's responsibilities in successful scrum delivery are made clear from an Agile perspective.

This course is essential for people who will be receiving the output from a Scrum Team on behalf of the business.

Professional Scrum Developer™ Course (PSD)*

PSD gives a programming code agnostic view of how to operate within a development team using Scrum. The course is structured around modern software engineering practices using the Scrum framework to cope with changes. There is a key focus on learning how to develop increments of potentially releasable functionality from a realistic Product Backlog. During the course, Scrum Teams work on requirements engineering, design, development, testing, integration, and deployment within a single iteration. The course teaches how the use of Agile engineering practices and supportive Application Lifecycle Management tools improve a development team's capabilities and effectiveness.

This course is aimed at all developers that will operate as part of a scrum team, or those that need to be able to integrate at a technical level with scrum teams.
